# ASSISTANT DIRECTOR VISION AFFAIRS FOR GENERAL CONFERENCE OF SDA





**JUNE 27-JULY 1** 

I was looking through the San Diego's Tourism "101 Things To Do" looking for activities that might interest us, when I came to "Great Opportunity to Ride Hogs!" Wow, I thought. That is something I don't remember at any convention! Visions of Eddye,

(If you think it's time to change convention hosts, we'll understand!). Anyway, we did find about 98 other things we could do as time permits.

We hope you arrive Thursday evening to register. Friday, there is Balboa Park, the nation's largest cultural park, 1200 acres with 15 major museums, (example, the SD Automobile, featuring dozens of rare ones), performing arts venues, beautiful gardens and the San Diego Zoo. There are trams to ride and a miniature railroad that rumbles over 4 acres of the park.

Sabbath afternoon, we are planning to go to the Birch Aquarium with its 5,000 specimens of fish and invertebrates--a shark tank too! (We are hoping to have sunset vespers on the beach.)

Saturday nite there is Old Town San Diego with shopping and restaurants with great Mexican food.

Sunday we want to take the ferry to Coronado Island, which has some of America's finest beaches. The Ferry Landing has many unique shops and many places to eat. We are working on a vision service project, probably for Sun Afternoon. Sunday evening will probably be the auction.

Saving the best for last, Monday we go to the African Safari Park with its 9 different safaris to get us up close and personal with over 3,500 exotic animals. Trams and guides available.

Of course we will be tucking time in for the usual business meetings. Other places of interest: Midway Aircraft, Gaslamp Quarter, Little Italy with great restaurants and a couple of antique shops, Old Town Trolley Tours. We had such a nice walk along water's edge, watching sail boats with their crisp white sails, and being energized by the cool ocean breeze--I can hardly wait until we go back!
